

Notice of functions exercised on behalf of an agency under the *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2022 (PID Act)*

Under the PID Act 2022, icare may exercise functions on behalf of another agency or another entity (s81(2), PID Act), or arrange for another agency or another entity (other than another agency) to exercise functions on its behalf (s81(3), PID Act).
